Thanks for the clarification.

In the API perspective, when you add a geo targeting on a line item, what is required is the [id](#) of the location, not the name of the location. You can check this [example](#) (in Java) from the client library.

In UI, you can change the display language (e.g. German) of your network. So, when you target a location on your line item, it appears that you are targeting a location in a local language. But in API, there is no service available to change the language of any entities (e.g. geo targets). API will always display the entities in English.
