Thanks for the clarification.

In the API perspective, when you add a geo targeting on a line item, what is required is the id of the location, not the name of the location. You can check this example (in Java) from the client library.

In UI, you can change the display language (e.g. German) of your network. So, when you target a location on your line item, it appears that you are targeting a location in a local language. But in API, there is no service available to change the language of any entities (e.g. geo targets). API will always display the entities in English.
